Apple, peach, cherry, and fig trees. Berry patches, vegetable and herb gardens, flowers, and garden art. A Certified Wildlife Habit!

1 **6203 Brookside Dr**

Corner lot including a 'Secret Garden.' This year's theme colors are purple and yellow. All annuals are grown from seeds indoors under grow lights

2 **6123 Dellbank Dr**

Small yard where the front boasts mature lace hydrangea bushes, while the back showcases a rose and lavender garden

3 **6203 Dellbank Dr — National Wildlife Federation certified.**

Goal is environmentally friendly place of beauty for all; food for us; shelter, water, and food for our wildlife. Deer resistant a must. Fruit trees, fig tree, blueberries, raspberries, and blackberries, strawberries & herbs. Ornamental trees, shrubs, perennials all tucked into small lot. Most of garden is < 3 yrs old

4 **6200 Meadowbrook Dr**

Color and variety abound. Yard art, spinners, bird baths and feeders.

5 **6204 Meadowbrook Dr**

Free-spirited garden—started out as a memorial to my folks and became a collection of plants from family and friends.

6 **Community Garden — Orchard Grove Farm**
6700 Orchard Grove Ave

Orchard Grove Farm Fruit and vegetable farm established 2017. Practicing organic, sustainable, and permaculture methods to build soil health and create biodiversity. We have apple, pear, peach, persimmon, and pawpaw trees here along with hazelnut, elderberry, blackberry shrubs and myriad of perennial and annual plants

7 **6212 Parkridge Ave**

Newly established, deer resistant, xeriscape, decorative and utilitarian

8 **4000 W 63 St**

A Cottage Garden in front, woodland garden and small vegetable garden in back

9 **4088 W 57 St**

Our garden has evolved over 20 years; now the job is primarily weeding, thinning, and weeding! Most annuals are self-seeding such as larkspur and geranium, joined by perennials that multiply, such as daisies, iris, lily of the valley, and coreopsis. A dozen different ground covers add color and texture.

10 **4113 W 50 St**

Features small raised beds, flowers, herbs, vegetables, and whimsical decorations

11 **4201 West 42 St**

1925 Arts & Crafts Bungalow with front and side gardens

12 **3517 Krather**

Private backyard garden—small space made for relaxing

13 **3444 Memphis Ave**

A colorful mix of perennials and annuals runs along the sidewalk in front of this century home. It was going to be a rock garden but it's evolved over time. A shade garden along the side of the house includes ferns, hosta, astilbe, brunnera and Lenten rose.

14 **4106 Spokane Ave**

Charming Century Home on brick street with colorful gardens and yard art

15 **4410 Spokane Ave**

We Love Our Garden

16 **4410 Bucyrus Ave**

Vegetable garden with multiple beds and custom-built borders

- 17 4225 Wichita avenue**
Organic urban farm and urban garden for home use and our small catering business in Lakewood, OH. Rain barrel water system with charcoal filters promoting self-sustainability and community alliance
- 18 5608 Stickney Ave**
We have a unique assortment of berries, fruit trees (Pawpaws!), flowers, native plants, vegetables, and more spread throughout a deep backyard
- 19 4325 Sunnyhill Circle – Greg’s One Stop Shop and Chomp** (Also accessible via Bern Circle at end of W 10 St; enter thru stone walls) This is a three-quarter acre nature preserve. Among the trees are Tupelo, Elm, Ginkgo, Pawpaw and Buckeye. Three River Birches grace the center of the field. Signs are posted around the property with the history and use of each plant.
- 20 409 South Ridge Drive**
Backyard garden with various flowers, plants, and vegetables.
- 21 306 South Ridge Dr**
Backyard garden with a pond and waterfall. Vegetable garden in side yard
- 22 4397 West 10th St**
Cozy little backyard refuge
- 23 1509 Ferman**
Front bed has a pastel theme and the back makes use of hard scape materials found at the house 26 years ago. A great shade garden for hot summer days.
- 24 Community Garden – Benjamin Franklin Community Garden, 1905 Spring Rd** (behind school) Largest community garden in OH, located behind an elementary school. Children’s and demo gardens, perennials/veggies. Awards from Cuyahoga Fair.
- 25 4651 Broadale Rd**
Front has blue spruce tree, rhododendrons, English boxwood, and more. Side of house has pink azalea, hydrangea, spirea, and annuals. The back garden has annuals and perennials, including honeysuckle, as well as container garden with herbs and tomatoes. Queen Anne’s Lace, Pussy willow, mint, and other perennials in a wilder back garden.
- 26 4693 Dornur**
My garden is cottage style with accent on native plant material. The show-stopping front yard has been evolving over the years with rock gardens and native plants
- 27 2206 Oak Park Ave**
Private Home Garden
