



Fairfax has a rich cultural history as one of Cleveland’s historically black neighborhoods and is the origin community of Langston Hughes, Jesse Owens, Dorothy Dandridge, Bobby Womack and other notable sources of cultural inspiration. Fairfax is also home to Karamu House, the nation’s first inter-racial theater and arts center, as well as numerous historically black churches located in historic buildings.

GardenWalk gives residents an opportunity to showcase their investments in urban sustainability, home renovations and community pride. Currently underway between Cedar and Quincy Avenues, Innovation Square is a mixed-use, mixed-income development of 500+ new housing units and commercial spaces available for lease. 18 8869 Cedar Ave – ABC/Fairfax Community Garden at Antioch Baptist Church
Designed in 2017 by late Mr. Rory, this garden provides fresh produce to the community, Cleveland Clinic employees, various organizations,

and passersby. Raised beds are growing vertically to increase yield. It forms a maze for walking through, with vegetables, herbs, pollinator flowers, apple and peach tree.

Serene oasis with colorful perennials and annuals with a view that says “Welcome.”

Art, rocks, vegetables, ground cover, flowers, and flowering shrubs come together to make a statement about beauty and sustainability.

22 Lucia Garden Walkway – Between Lucia Ave and Amos Ave
Pastoral walkway connects Lucia Ave and Amos Ave just west of E 82nd St, providing a pleasant mid-block pedestrian connection and outdoor seating in an idyllic park-like setting.
