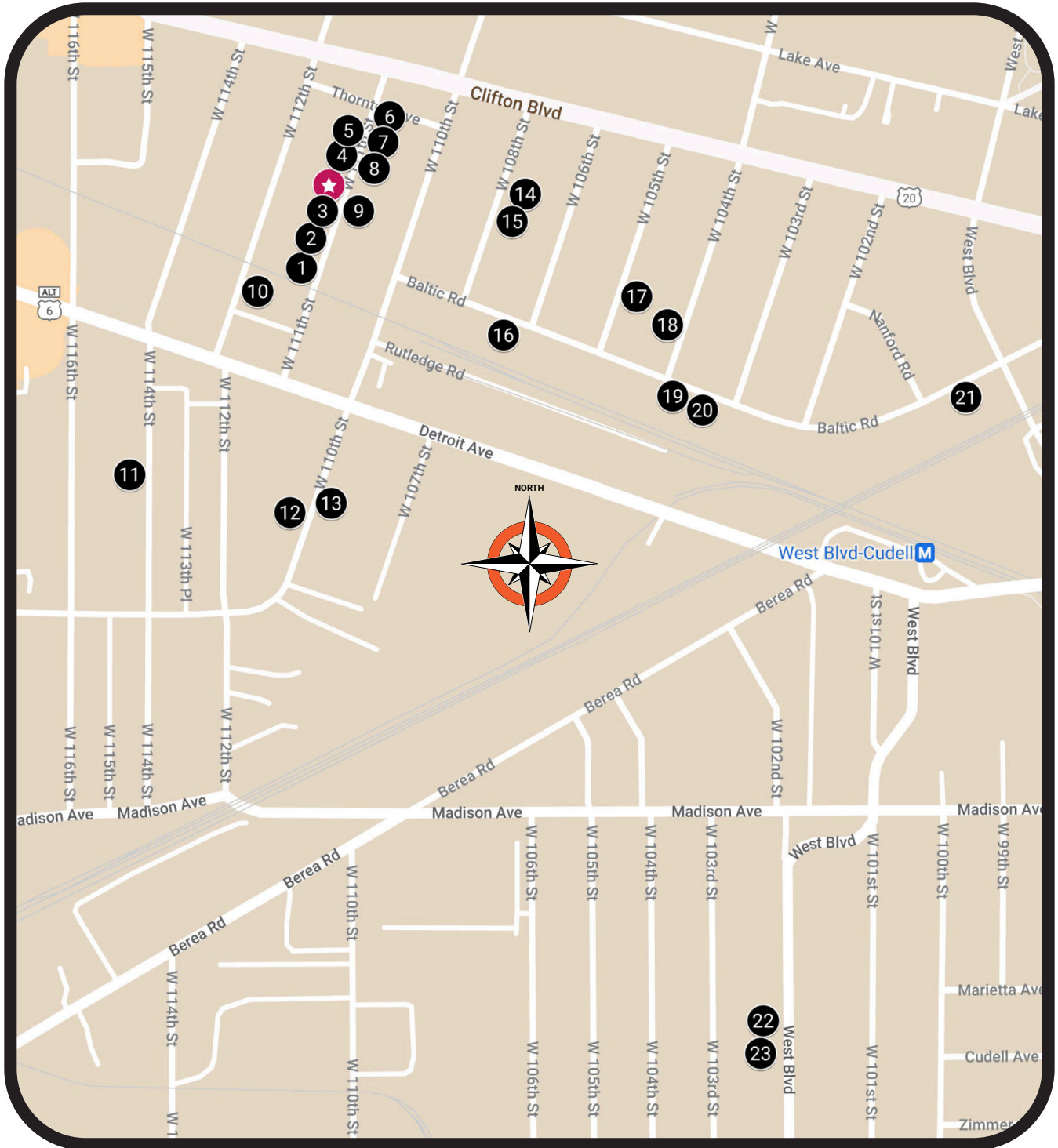

Clifton-Baltic

The Clifton-Baltic area of the Edgewater neighborhood is distinguished by beautiful homes near the historic Clifton streetcar boulevard and Detroit Avenue. Residents here love to stroll to the many locally and LGBTQ owned businesses, as well as Edgewater Park and its beaches. RTA's Cleveland State Line provides a speedy connection to Downtown Cleveland to the east and the City of Lakewood to the west.

★ Information Station – 1308 W 111th St

Curbside garden, hedges and Magnolia tree add color and depth to our 1900 Victorian Stick Style home. Side garden flows back to the rear garden with perennials, rain gardens, and a raised vegetable garden. Creating a new area in the back garden.

1 1342 W 111th St

Front and back gardens, full of mature perennials and some native plants.

2 1324 W 111th St

Backyard Makeover. New shed and 6'x12' unique garden wall. Endemic perennials, vegetables, butterfly and hummingbird attractions.

3 1314 W 111th St

1st year homeowners cultivating a mix of floral and vegetable species.

4 1292 W 111th St

Glorious extension of David Gauchat's garden next door.

5 1288 W 111th St

French inspired gardens with fountains and numerous beds of various shrubs and flowers. Classical music is usually playing throughout the summer. A very prolific gardener lives here.

6 1267 W 111th St

Easy-going flower beds surround the house with self-designed and built cedar planter boxes in the front yard and vegetable and rose gardens in the back yard.

7 1273 W 111th St

We started with a plan but it's slowly turned into a collectors garden. We like a little of everything with limited organization. We generally like odd number plantings, but sometimes not. We consider these garden beds a continual work in progress :)

8 1293 W 111th St

Our front yard has a large pollinator garden (all credit to the lovely David Gauchat!). The backyard has a shrub garden, young paw-paw trees, some wildflowers and a raised veggie garden.

9 1313 W 111th

Certified wildlife habitat in an urban setting. 1896 Queen Anne with reimagined Victorian garden is no-mow, minimum rake, casual, eclectic, minimum chemicals, creative recycling. Stone/ brick patio with cement pond, rescued iron fencing and old firepit in backyard. Owners lived here since 1973.

10 W 112 St Garden

1361 W 112th St

We have had our community garden for 26 years. Over that time, the garden has become a place for neighbors to gather and for gardeners to learn and grow.

11 1446 W 114th St

Pollinator garden in raised metal beds along the sidewalk. Vegetable garden along the south side of house in 6'-6" of space

12 1452 W 110th St

Japanese landscape meets native Ohio woodland in this backyard oasis under a 200 yr old white oak tree. An arch of dutchman's pipe leads to a mix of Japanese maples, hinoki cypress, dogwoods, ferns, and giant hostas. Perennial garden, with bluestone patio and koi pond. Oversized lot brimming with plants and ideas!

13 1441 W 110th St – STAR GARDENER

Lovingly restored 1905 Folk Victorian home on double lot has terraced gardens planted with river birch trees, deer-resistant perennials, and sunflowers, as well as a stone patio next to a reflecting pool filled with water lilies and hyacinths. Feel free to enjoy the front, side, and rear gardens.

English Rose Garden

15 1293 W 108th St

For the past 10 years, we have joined our neighbor to beautify our front yards. Together, we have over 1000 roses on our bushes. Both yards are certainly a spectacle on West 108th. Along with special lighting, we try to create a beautiful experience whenever people walk by.

16 10609 Baltic Rd

A unique garden with vintage and creative planters. Lots of perennials and annuals. Do not overlook the secret back garden.

17 1317 W 105th St

Native-planted front yard rain garden, flax-planted tree lawn (part of Rust Belt Fibershed Linen Project), and back yard vegetable garden and evolving greenspace.

18 1330 W 104th St

Growing garden with ornamental flowers in front and native pollinators and a raised bed veggie patch in the back.

19 10317 Baltic Rd

Back yard garden: my private "Sanctuary of Peace!"

20 10313 Baltic Rd

Formal in the front and wild in the rear. From sun-loving plants to shade garden, a mixture of annuals and perennials abound. Chickens, honeybees, and turtles, Oh My! Tour our bird feeding area, woodland hillside and our new water garden project under construction. No construction helmets required.

21 10015 Baltic Rd

Amateur home gardens, front and back of house, with an eclectic mix of perennials, annuals and edibles.

22 2094 West Blvd

Wild and unruly, with a patio in the tree lawn.

23 2110 West Blvd

Flowers, herbs, and veggies with some surprises.
