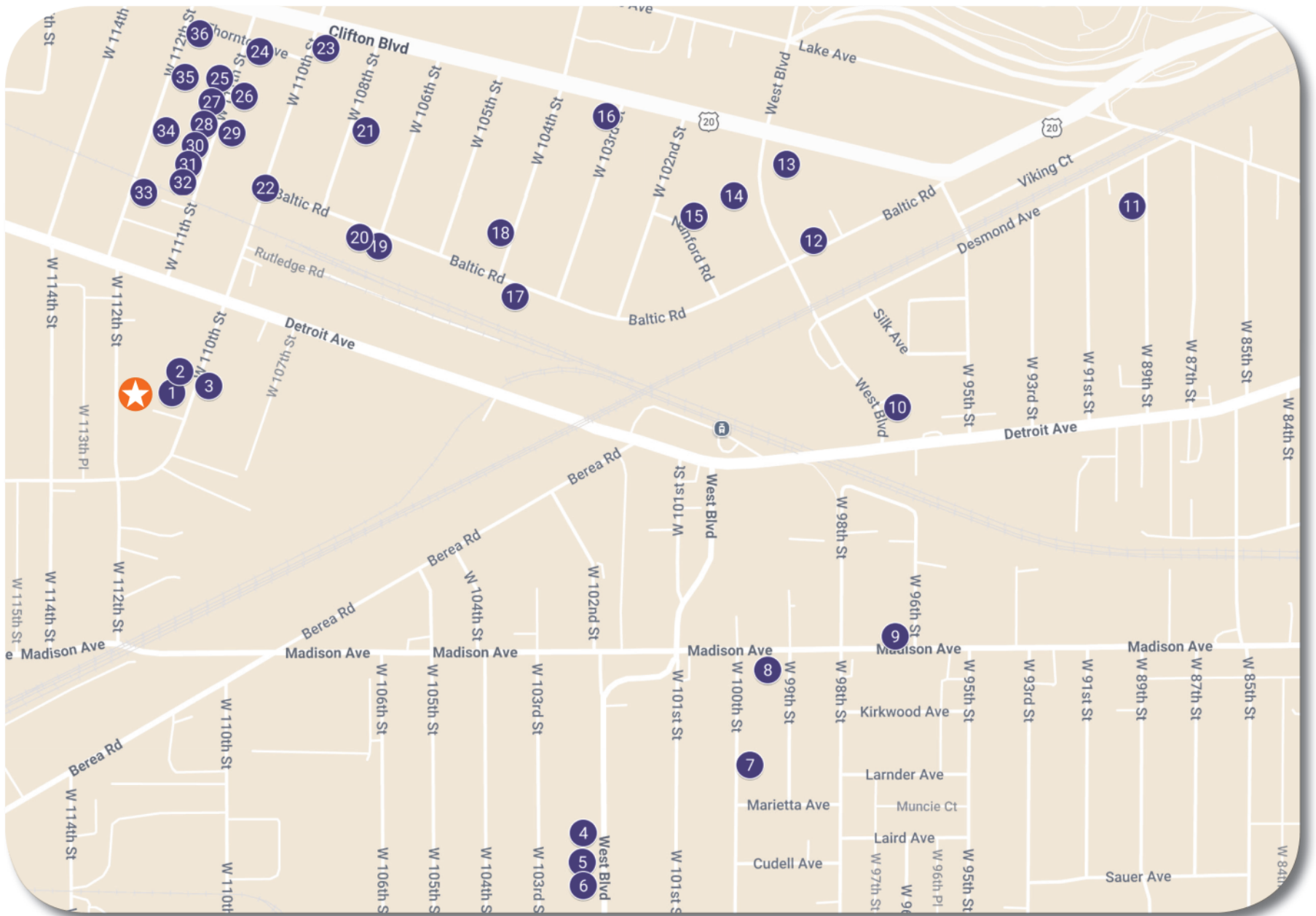

1. 1452 W 110th St

Japanese landscape meets native Ohio woodland in backyard oasis under century old white oak tree. Arch of dutchman's pipe leads to a mix of Japanese maples, hinoki cypress, dogwoods, ferns, and giant hostas. Perennial garden, bluestone patio, and koi pond. Oversize lot brimming with plants and ideas! |W|

2. 1446 W 110th St

Formal English Garden on a former vacant lot. Stroll through several jewel-toned perennial beds towards a Victorian Greenhouse full of orchids and tropicals. Bluestone patio, reflecting pool, and vegetable garden round out the lot. Our first year creating this brand new garden with lots of help- come see how much we get accomplished! |N| |W|

3. 1441 W 110th St

This evolving garden features a bamboo fence, two wildflower beds, and newly planted redbud and dogwood trees. Designed to reduce lawn, support pollinators, and provide cut flowers, it brings together layered planting and inviting outdoor spaces that grow more established each year. |W|

Good Earth Farm Stand

CBN Block Club - Pollinator / Rain Garden

In 2020, Clifton-Baltic Neighbors Block Club planted a pollinator / rain garden at Baltic Children's Park. This demonstration garden collects playground rainwater, using native plants and amended soils to filter out pollutants. The native plants offer a beautiful setting with varied bloom times, boosting biodiversity over turf grass while providing food and habitat for bees and butterflies. |N|

Natural/Native Wildlife Habitat Garden with various Bird, Bees and Butterfly host and Nectar Plants. |N| |W|

24. 1267 W 111th St

Evolving landscaping and gardens which include lush flowers in cedar planter boxes, in-ground and raised vegetable gardens, and landscape beds featuring a selection of rose bush clusters. Dense greenery around the perimeter creates a peaceful retreat within the city, while affording open lawn space for the kids to play.

25. 1288 W 111th St

French inspired garden created by chef David runs throughout the property with sandstone walls, statues, window boxes, and a large fountain. A must see garden on your visit. |W| **TROLLEY STOP**

26. 1293 W 111th St

The front garden is beautifully designed by the lovely David Gauchat. The backyard houses a mix of natives, vegetables, herbs, berry bushes, pawpaw trees, and cut flowers grown from seed, along with a "chicken tunnel" bordering the yard. |N| |C|

27. 1308 W 111th St

1896 Victorian "stick style" home featuring magnolia tree, hedges, tree lawn garden, side garden flowing to an informal backyard with raised bed vegetable garden. New solar panel system installed 2025.

28. 1314 W 111th St

A sustainability-focused garden with a lush clover lawn and flowering tree lawn. Raised beds with an array of edibles, nurtured with local compost, lead to a backyard of treasures including a variety of planters bursting with herbs, vegetables, flowers, and a charming treehouse surrounded by a rain garden. Our goal is to embrace native species for pollinators with plans for an all-edible garden. |N|

29. 1313 W 111th St

Recycle-happy hippies manage (barely) a National Wildlife Habitat yard masquerading as a Victorian garden. Artwork, artifacts and music are part of our scene. Different projects compete for our attention every year. |W|
