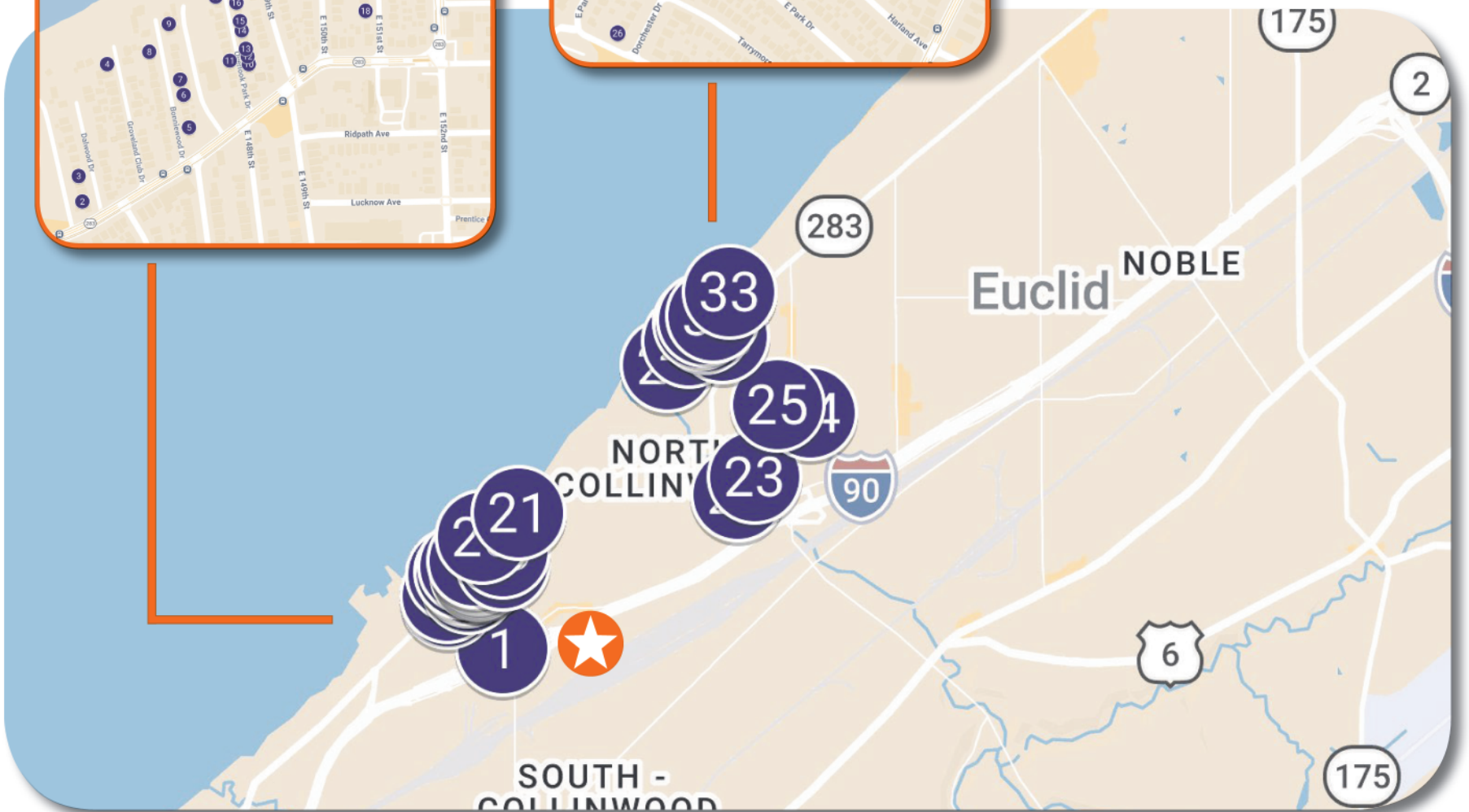
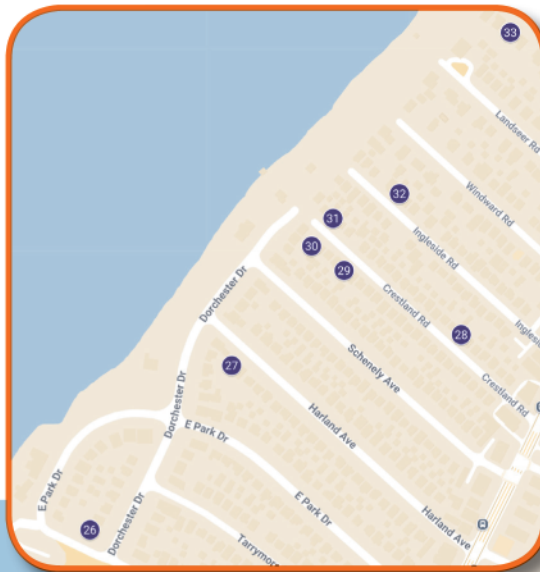
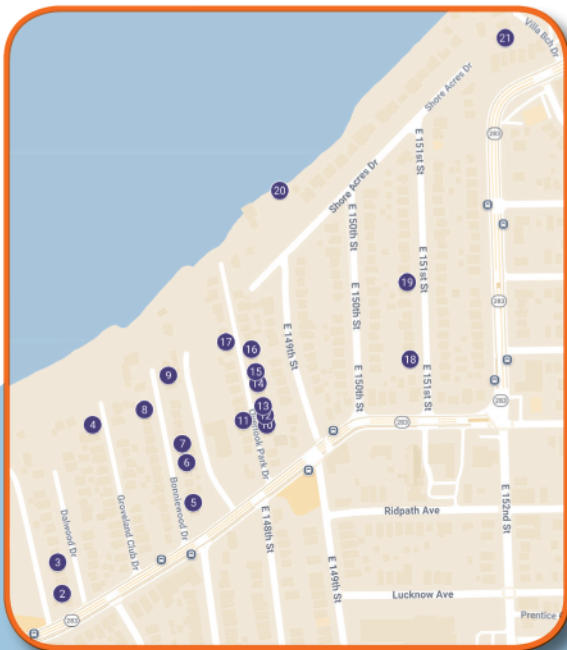

The popular Waterloo Arts and Entertainment District offers a variety of live music venues, including the famous Beachland Ballroom, art galleries, and old world food producers. **1. 15006 Westropp Ave**

**Meadow City Native Plant Nursery**

Our native demonstration garden is in its fourth year! All the plants in our garden descend from local wild populations. Because these species have grown in our region for thousands of years, birds, butterflies, and other pollinators have come to depend on them for food and shelter. As our garden evolves, we hope to show how these wildflowers can bring beauty and life to people's yards. |N| **INFO STATION**

**2. 372 Dalwood Dr**

I focus my garden on sustaining pollinators and providing a variety of color throughout the season. While I have native plants throughout all areas, one quadrant is devoted entirely to natives. I've nearly reached my goal of a 100% grass-free yard! The garden in the back features a small wildlife pond with native plants and raised food beds, as well as berries and herbs. |N| |W|

**3. 360 Dalwood Dr**

Front yard is a mix of sunny native pollinators, roses, and a shady area with more native species slowly filling in. Side raised herb and veggie beds. Back near house fully native bed including goldenrod, white snake root, aster, milkweed, and evening primrose. |N|

### 17. 304 Overlook Park Dr

A nurtured chaos garden. Very hosta forward.

### 18. 300 E 151st St

Two hand-painted 55-gallon rain barrels and one large 30 year old Tree Peony. |W|

### 19. 272 E 151st St

Step into the urban gardens of John and Adam. The front yard is a welcoming mix of native plants, perennials, and pollinator-friendly blooms, the backyard invites you to linger beneath a pergola surrounded by more natives and perennials. A touching memorial kitty garden adds a personal note to the space. You'll find art, birdhouses, and water features to discover, plus refreshments to enjoy. |W|

### 20. 14915 Shore Acres Dr

Large garden right on Lake Erie. We have over 150 daylilies, plus many other plants (e.g., hostas, astilbes, giant fleece plants, Joe Pye, and hydrangeas). And a really tall plant! Come see it and guess what it is! |W|

### 21. 15441 Lakeshore Blvd, #4

Tucked away on the shores of Lake Erie, we hope you enjoy our little urban oasis of Villa Beach! Our garden features a native pollinator habitat and a container vegetable garden along with some other features that make lounging in the backyard a breeze! The Villa Beach entrance is 15441 Lakeshore Blvd. Park in the Visitor lot and House #4 is light blue and to the right of Visitor parking. |N|

### 22. 17902 Nottingham Rd

Perennials, especially hosta, at the old (c. 1878) yellow farmhouse.

### 23. 1004 Dillewood Rd

2+ acres of woodland and gardens bordered by Euclid Creek. It's our fourth year growing fruits, vegetables, natives and more across raised and in-ground garden beds. Come take a walk and say hello! |N| |W|

### 24. 18623 Chickasaw Ave

The main features of this backyard are a koi pond fed by a stream with a waterfall. And a gazebo with one leg in the water. The gazebo has a beautiful bluestone patio under it. The front yard has boulders and various other size rocks creating a natural looking raised bed. All the landscaping was created by the homeowner. |W|

### 25. 18309 LaSalle Ave

Front yard is both vegetables and ornamental, along with a mixture of natives. The back yard has a small pond and patio surrounded by natives and pollinator-friendly perennials. |N| |W|

### 26. 17217 Dorchester Dr

**East Shore Park Club Private Beach Club**  
East Shore Park Club is a private club available to residents within the neighborhood allotment. Members enjoy use of the clubhouse, access to the lake, and private flower beds and planters scattered throughout. The general public is invited to gather every other Thursday throughout the summer for our ESPC Summer Concert Series. A great space to enjoy a sunset and catch up with friends and family.

### 27. 17302 Harland Ave

Diverse native plant garden in the front yard and container vegetable garden in the back. Front garden produces blooms from early spring to fall. Back garden focuses on heirloom tomatoes and herbs, with ornamental tropicals. |N|

### 28. 17717 Crestland Rd

Perennials, vegetables, small fruits.

### 29. 17526 Crestland Rd

Relaxing with a sip of sun tea as blooms abound after a day in the dirt on small plot of paradise next to the lakefront is a perfect way to spend a wonderful summer day.
