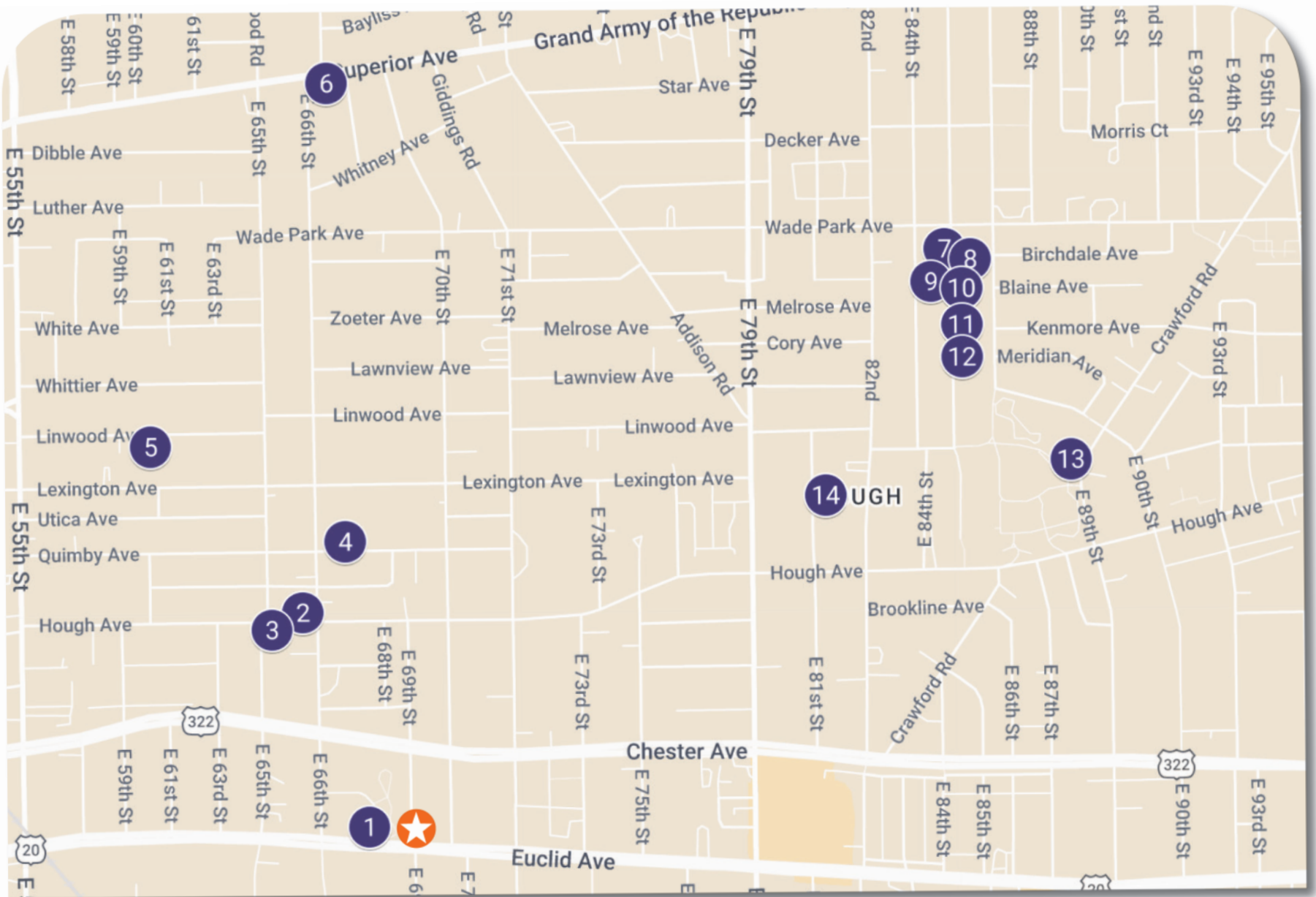




SCAN FOR INTERACTIVE MAP
