

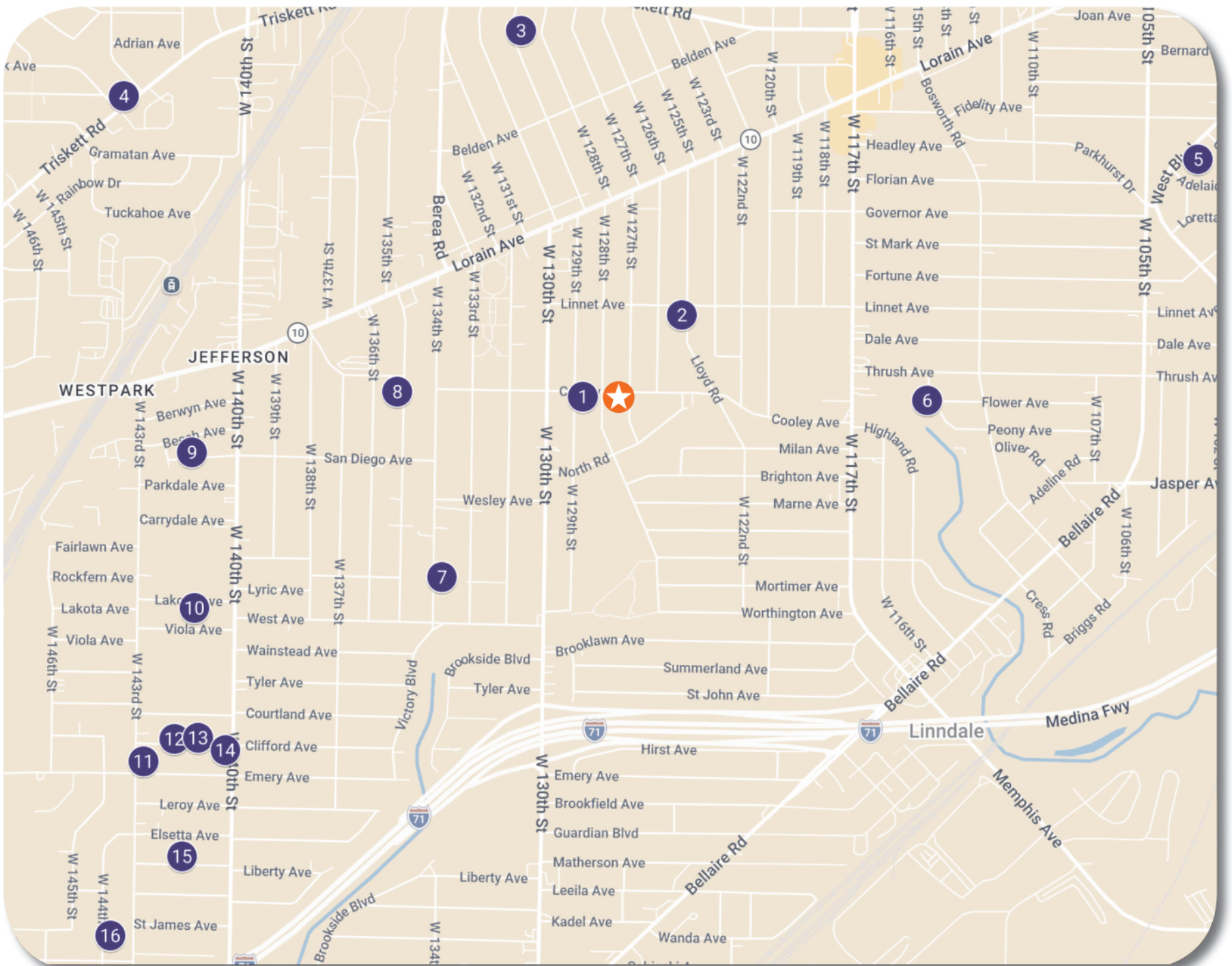
WEST PARK/ JEFFERSON

Jefferson is part of the larger West Park neighborhood, a former suburb annexed by Cleveland in 1922 that today is one of Cleveland's most diverse Communities. Jefferson was home to West Park founder and namesake John M. West whose house still stands today at 3684 W 138th St. Located east of Kamm's, from the Red Line tracks to W 117th, Jefferson offers a variety of involvement opportunities and exciting events to neighbors and visitors alike, including a weekly outdoor summer concert series held at Jefferson Park each July ("Jefferson Rocks! Welcome to my backyard of wonder — a whimsical garden packed with quirky art, travel finds, and cheerful surprises around every corner. It's the perfect summer spot to relax, smile, and enjoy the outdoors.

6. 3612 W 114th St

Bay Branch Farm

Bay Branch Farm packs an abundance of food and flowers into 1/2 acre across 2 backyards in the city. Using organic practices, raised beds, and high tunnels, we grow more than you'd imagine possible. On garden walk day, step inside our 30'x72' tunnel of towering tomatoes, wander our flower fields, and explore our greens tunnel. Come check out what's possible in an urban lot! |N|

9. 14112 San Diego Ave

Vegetables, herbs, native plants, along with colorful annuals and perennials packed into a tiny front yard that's been converted into a garden. |N|

10. 14107 Lakota Ave

A funky little front garden full of flowers and lawn ornaments. |N|

11. 4029 W 143rd St

Professionally landscaped with new fence, firepit, louvered gazebo, small butterfly garden, vegetables, dahlias and zinnias. |W|

12. 14120 Clifford Ave

This lot is one-half of a husband-and-wife pair of adjacent gardens. Highlights include a raised planter vegetable garden with a rainbarrel. Front and side gardens include a mix of perennials and annuals. In the back a fence border garden beds run the length of the yard full of perennials with approximately 50% of them being natives. A small seating area is nestled within the perennial border. |N|

13. 14116 Clifford Ave

This lot is the other half of the husband-and-wife pair of adjacent gardens. The front cottage style beds feature a rainbow mix of echinacea, several varieties of rudbeckia and hydrangeas. The back garden is several beds composed of approximately 50% native perennials and a herb garden. Our homebrewing setup was used to craft a floral beer using local plants to share samples with guests. |N|

14. 4022 W 140th St

You'll find a mix of seasonal flowers, potted plants, and personal touches that make this tiny space feel warm and inviting. Though small in size, the garden reflects the idea that beauty can grow anywhere with a little care and creativity. We hope as you walk through, you feel inspired to slow down, breathe deeply, and enjoy the simple beauty nature brings.
