

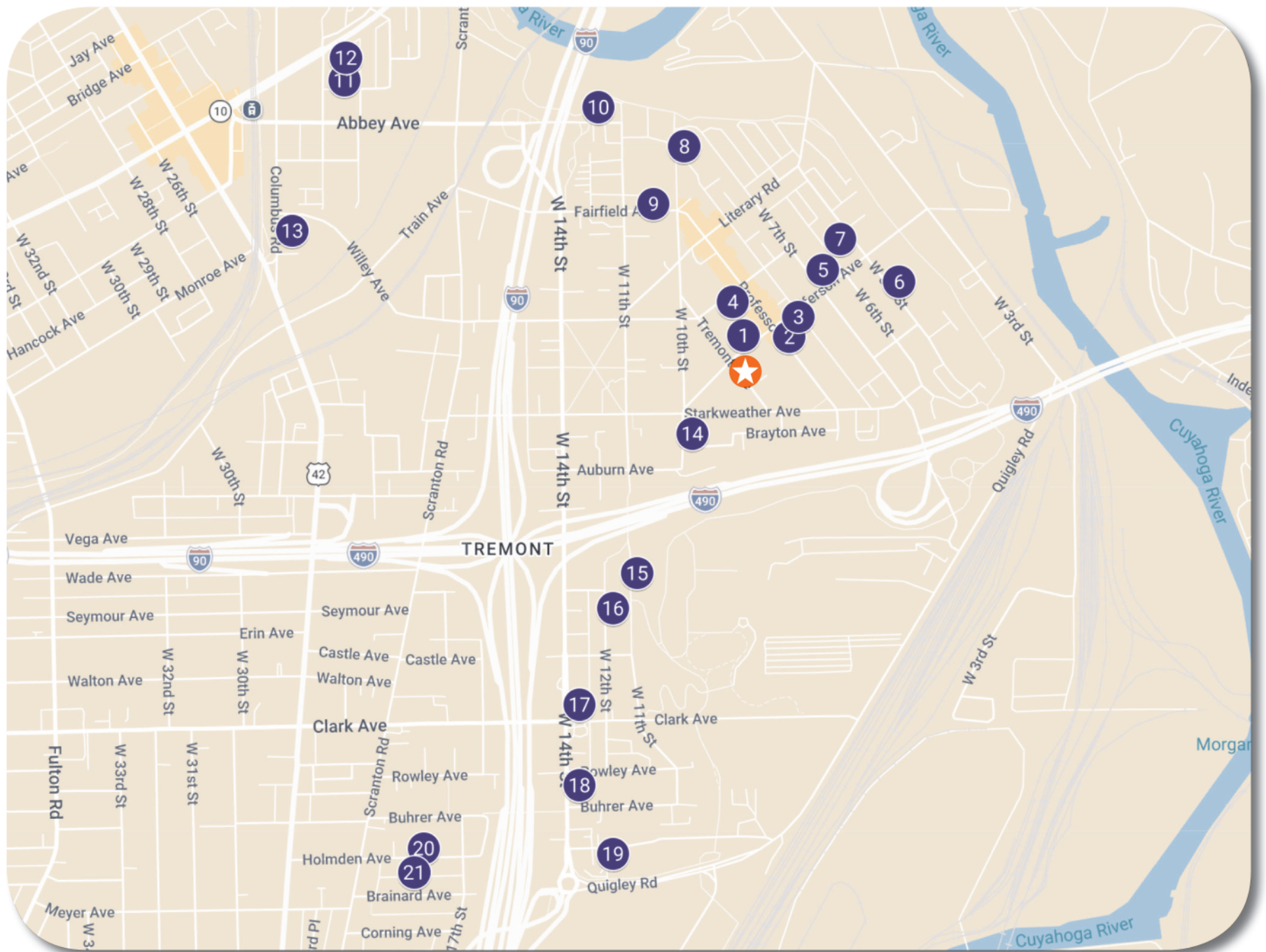

Situated along the Towpath Trail and just minutes from Downtown Cleveland, the neighborhoods of Tremont and Duck Island, are where visitors mingle seamlessly with residents, business owners, artists and entrepreneurs. Tremont is one of Cleveland's oldest neighborhoods with a rich history dating back to the early 1800s. Today the neighborhood is known for its award-winning restaurants, lively art scene, boutique shops, scenic churches, and fun-filled events. Duck Island is the neighborhood between Tremont and Ohio City and home to the oldest beer garden in Cleveland, Forest City Brewery.

1. 850 Jefferson Ave

Cleveland Public Library
Jefferson Campus Garden

A native Ohio garden and bioswale with plantings supporting a pollinator habitat. Our garden blooms every spring, shelters monarchs every summer, glows copper-gold every fall, and stands quietly beautiful every winter, telling the story of Ohio's natural heritage and Tremont's community pride to every person who passes by the Jefferson Campus.

3. 815 Jefferson Ave

4. 841 College Ave

Neighborhood Family Practice garden

5. 2395 W 7th St

Backyard oasis with all the shrubs, trees, birds and flowers. Featuring The Cabana, The Tiki Lounge, a Scott Radke mural, and Sophia, the cat who thinks I do all of this for her.

What began as open grass has grown into a layered storybook cottage garden, rich with trees, blooms, and handcrafted details. In the heart of the city, this evolving space blends urban roots with countryside charm, honoring patience, creativity, and the quiet magic of cultivating beauty where it's least expected.

7. 2344 W 5th St

St. Wendelin Prayer Garden

15. 2835 W 11th St

Erich Hooper

16. 2895 W 12th St

This is my beginner garden! I moved into a home with wonderful flowers already, and am beginning to find my way to keep it flourishing. My garden features a front yard filled with diverse plants and flowers including large purple geraniums and a red rose bush. My side yard has an herb garden, wildflowers and veggies growing.

17. 3063 W 14th St

We have spent the past 4 years converting our full-sun front lawn into a native habitat. We started with a prairie garden pack from Cuyahoga Soil and Water and added more species over the years. Today, nearly the whole yard is covered with a pollinator garden. Something is always in bloom! [|N|](#)

Through the use of vertical plantings, houseplants, annuals and perennials, this garden provides a case study of what can be done on a small urban lot. Found and repurposed objects provide added interest and charm.

19. 1193 Holmden Ave

I have the best of both gardening worlds - a shade garden in the front half and a sun garden in back half of my property. The beds are filled with perennial flowering plants and shrubs along with some food bearing plants mixed in.

20. 1832 Holmden Ave
